**OpenLV – Security Acceptability**

The purpose of this letter is to state the current security position for the OpenLV project.

The initial phase for the OpenLV trials involves deploying hardware to low-voltage substations, however this hardware does not physically or logically communicate with existing power control networks (such as DNP3). Further there will be no control of power distribution from the LV-CAP™ platform, nor will the platform be connected to devices which could potentially control power distribution. There is no cyber-security risks to Power Distribution Operators and their operations.

Security requirements have been defined and initial designs reviewed, with responses from other stakeholders of OpenLV. These shall form part of a Cyber Security report which can be used for assurance during the later parts of the trials.

NCC Group's opinion is that the initial trial should commence.
